



Rev. Prof. Alejandro Crosthwaite, OP is Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences; Professor (Professore Straordinario) of Catholic Social Teaching, Social & Political Ethics, and Media Studies at the Faculty of Social Sciences (FASS) at the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas (Rome); Assistant Professor in the ISSR Mater Ecclesiae, Adjunct Professor of the Faculty of Theology and Public Relations pro-Officer of the same University.

Prof. Crosthwaite completed his doctoral studies in Theology and Society at Marquette University, Milwaukee, WI (2006), concentrating in Social Ethics and Catholic Social Thought as well as Mass Media studies focusing on the interaction between public theology, culture, film and social transformation. On June 3, 2010, Fr. Crosthwaite obtained his License in Sacred Theology (S.T.L.) from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas focusing on "Globalization in Light of Catholic Social Teaching."

On February 7, 2011, Prof. Crosthwaite was granted tenure (docente stabili) with the rank of Associate Professor (aggregato) of Catholic Social Teaching and Social & Political & Mass Media in the Faculty of Social Sciences.

On August 22, 2016, Prof. Crosthwaite was granted the rank of Professor (professore straordinario) of Catholic Social Teaching and Social & Political & Mass Media in the Faculty of Social Sciences.

Prof. Crosthwaite is currently a member of the Society of Christian Ethics, The Catholic Theological Society of America, the American Academy of Religion, and The Society for the Study of Christian Ethics (U.K.), and Societas Ethica (E.U.).

He is the author of several lectures and articles on the social and political thought of St. Thomas Aquinas, Latin American & Latino/a social ethics, and Media Studies.
