



**Flavio Felice (Turin, May 15 1969)** is full professor of History of Political Doctrines at the Molise University of Studies. Since 2010, he has been Director of the International Research Area *Caritas in Veritate*, on the Social Doctrine of the Church, at the Pontifical Lateran University. He is visiting professor at the Catholic University *Sedes Sapientiae* of Lima (Peru). He is President of the Tocqueville-Acton Centre Studies and Adjunct Scholar at the American Enterprise Institute and Non-Resident Research Fellow at the Faith & Reason Institute, both in Washington DC. Since 2001, he has been the general coordinator of the “*Centesimus Annus Foundation Pro Pontifice*” training courses in Catholic Social Teaching. He is author of several books, among which: “Capitalismo e cristianesimo” (Rubbettino, 2002); “Prospettiva neocon” (Rubbettino, 2005), “Welfare society” (Rubbettino, 2007), “Economia sociale di mercato” (Rubbettino, 2008), “Lo spirito della globalizzazione” (Rubbettino, 2011), “Istituzioni, persona e mercato. La persona nel contesto del liberalismo delle regole” (Rubbettino, 2013). He won the 2014 Capri Award, in the philosophy section, with the book “La vita alla luce della fede. Riflessioni filosofiche e socio-politiche sull'enciclica 'Lumen fidei'” (Rubbettino, 2013).
